



Winter Recreation Policies

RENTER: the person who provides the account number/payment and who undertakes all financial responsibility regardless of who is using the equipment.

Liability

- All RENTERS will be required to fill out a waiver form prior to participation.
- All Children under the age of 18 are required to have an adult complete the required waiver documentation and acknowledge consent prior to participating.
- Children between the ages of 12-18 are permitted to use the equipment on their own so long as parents acknowledge, consent and sign a Parental Permission Form.
- Children under 12 years of age must always have a parent or legal guardian (18 years or older) with them while operating or using equipment.

Booking Policies

RENTER understands that all equipment is available on a first come, first served basis. This means that Friday Harbour cannot reserve any recreational rentals ahead of time. If the RENTER returns equipment before the two-hour rental period is over, there will be no refund issued for the remaining time of the rental period.

Rental Pricing

- Complimentary Rental equipment is available exclusively to enrolled Homeowners.
- Guests of enrolled Homeowners receive a discount of 25% off all regularly priced rental equipment.
- Public and non-enrolled Homeowners will be charged the regular posted price for all equipment rentals.
- Charges and discounts may or may not apply for specific guided excursions and activities.
- Participants are responsible for understanding charges prior to booking, as discounts/refunds will not be issued within the established cancellation period.

Rental Periods

- All equipment rentals are based on a two-hour time period, apart from Skate Aids, which can be rented on an hourly basis.

- The RENTER agrees to return equipment rentals on or before the two-hour rental period expiration.
 - If equipment is rented with less than two hours before close, the RENTER understands that the rental price will not be discounted.
 - Fat bike, cross country skis and snowshoe rentals will not be available after sunset. These rentals must be returned by 5:00pm.

Damage to Friday Harbour Equipment

- Friday Harbour certifies that the equipment provided to each Guest is in good mechanical and physical condition. Any known damage or problems will be listed on the equipment sign out sheet and reviewed with the RENTER by a member of the Friday Harbour Recreation Team.
- RENTER is responsible to inspect rental equipment and will continue the rental term without any additional representation or warranty by Friday Harbour. If equipment has damage or problems not listed on the equipment sign out sheet, the RENTER is responsible for notifying the Friday Harbour Recreation Team before use of the equipment or rental period begins.
- RENTER acknowledges and understands that equipment is to be returned in the same condition as at the commencement of the rental period.
- If the rental equipment is not left in suitable condition, the RENTER acknowledges and understands that Friday Harbour will charge the RENTER for any repairs, replacement or special cleaning of any damaged or lost property.

Theft / Loss of Friday Harbour Equipment

- In case of theft or loss, the RENTER is responsible for the replacement value of the equipment borrowed. In the case of abuse or damage by any person, the RENTER will be charged for the repair or replacement of the equipment.

Theft / Loss of Personal Belongings

- It is expressly agreed that Friday Harbour shall not be liable for the loss or damage of any personal property left or stored by the RENTER at any time, including personal belongings left in lockers.

Equipment Safe Use

- The RENTER undertakes all financial responsibility regardless of who is using the equipment.
- The RENTER acknowledges and agrees that the equipment will only be operated by individuals listed in their rental booking.



- The RENTER warrants that the RENTER(s) is a qualified operator of said equipment.
- The RENTER will not allow any person who is not listed on their rental booking to operate any equipment owned by Friday Harbour.
- The RENTER will not operate the equipment, or permit anyone to operate the equipment, while under the influence of alcohol and/or drugs.
- The RENTER will be responsible to ensure that all users operate equipment within all Local, Provincial and Federal Laws and Regulations. It is the responsibility of the RENTER to obtain or have the knowledge and understanding regarding all such laws and regulations.
- The RENTER understands that conditions (weather, snow, ice etc.) are variable and that they must exercise caution, pre-planning and good judgment.
- If there is a weight or size restriction on the equipment being borrowed, the RENTER shall ensure that at no time will these restrictions be exceeded.
- Proper safety equipment must always be worn (i.e. helmet) by all participants operating or using equipment.

Return of Friday Harbour Equipment

- The RENTER acknowledges and understands that he/she will return all equipment to the rental site prior to, or promptly at the end time as agreed upon in their rental agreement.
- Should the RENTER(S) request equipment for additional time, the item is to be returned and a new booking inquiry made at that time.

Ice Rink Rules

Ice Rink Code of Conduct

- Alcohol and drug consumption are not allowed in or around the Rink.
- Smoking and vaping are not allowed in or around the Rink areas.
- A CSA approved helmet must be worn on the Rink surface at all times.
- No Homeowner or Guest is permitted on the Rink surface without skates and a helmet.
- Strollers, baby carriers, backpacks, chairs or any homemade skate assistance aid will not be permitted on the Rink surface.
- No sitting on the dasher boards.
- Carrying a child in your arms or on your back is not permitted.
- Hockey sticks or pucks are NOT permitted during Leisure Skate times.



- Inappropriate or unsafe behavior will not be permitted.
- No headsets, cell phones, cameras or handheld devices are to be used while on the Rink surface.
- No food or drink on the Rink surface.
- Homeowners and Guests are asked to skate at a reasonable and safe speed in the same direction as other skaters.
- Please report all incidents or injuries to the Rink staff immediately.
- All equipment is to be returned prior to close.

Shinny Hockey Rules

- A CSA approved helmet must be worn on the Rink surface at all times.
- For youth shinny programs, Rink staff will determine teams based on skill level and will also referee and encourage fair team play.
- This is a non-contact activity.
- Only hockey pucks provided by Friday Harbour Resort are permitted on the Rink surface.
- Pucks are to stay on the ice at all times. Slap shots are not permitted.
- Any behaviour that does not support fair play towards other Homeowners and Guests as well as Rink staff will not be tolerated.

Rink Capacity

- Children and adults: up to 60 people on the rink
- Adults: up to 40 people on the rink

Rink Closures

- The Rink may be closed at any time, without warning, due to weather, temperature, ice conditions, maintenance, private events, emergencies, etc.

Rink General Rules

- Skaters using the Rink will agree to and abide by all rules and code of conduct.
- The posted Rink schedule will be adhered to (i.e. No shinny games or equipment on the ice during leisure skate times).
- Homeowner skate times are reserved exclusively for Homeowners only. Homeowner Cards may be requested to be presented at any time.



- Skaters may be asked to leave, or Rink use may be denied if:
 - Rink users appear intoxicated
 - Vandalism of Rink, equipment etc. occurs
 - Abuse or harassment of staff or other skaters occurs
 - Any of the above rules are not being followed
- Only Rink and Friday Harbour staff are permitted to use shovels and other maintenance equipment on the ice.
- All accidents, injuries, damages etc. need to be reported to Friday Harbour staff immediately.

Cross Country Skiing

Skier's Code of Conduct

- Please stay on marked trails.
- Be courteous of other skiers.
- Never stop in the track. If you need a break or to stop for any reason, please vacate the track and leave enough room for someone to ski by.
- When a faster skier catches up to a slower skier going the same direction, the slower skier should yield the right of way.
- Ski with care and control and use caution.
- If you fall, move out of the track as quickly as possible.
- If you must remove your skis and walk for any reason, please stay as far away from the set tracks as possible.
- Keep pets off trails.
- Please return all equipment to the Outdoor Adventure Centre on the Beach when finished.

Friday Harbour Resort Property

Marina

- The RENTER agrees to read and observe all posted signage, including, but not limited to, staying off of the marked boardwalks.



- Under no circumstances will RENTER(S) and/or Guests enter onto the frozen lake water in the Marina Basin, lake or Beach areas with rented equipment.
- Access to the ice on the Marina and surrounding lake area is prohibited.

Nature Preserve

- The RENTER(S) agree to read and observe all posted signage in the Nature Preserve, including, but not limited to:
 - Staying on marked trails
 - Keeping pets on a leash
 - Picking up after pets
 - Disposing of trash in proper receptacles
- The RENTER understands that conditions (weather, snow, ice etc.) are variable and that they must exercise caution, pre-planning and good judgment.

General Rules

- The RENTER(S) must follow and obey the rules of the road at all times.
- Smoking is restricted to designated areas on Resort property.

Locker Rentals

- Lockers are available for rent inside the Outdoor Adventure Centre on the Beach.
- Lockers are available to rent for two-hour time periods.
- A key to an assigned locker is available from a member of the Recreation Team after payment is made.
- A fee of \$10 will be charged for any lost keys.
- Friday Harbour employees are permitted to remove items from lockers that have been left in the locker(s) beyond the paid rental period.
- Friday Harbour Resort is not responsible for lost, stolen or damaged property.
